


Child Sexual Abuse Pathway



Child Makes Disclosure or suspected CSA

MASH Notification or allocated to open Social Worker

Notify Police and SARC

Strategy Meeting (To also include SARC, Police, and Paediatrician & FME) If not held here must be held after victim visit. SARC will begin coordinating Forensic/wellbeing examination where appropriate.

Victim Visit completed by Police and Social services

Child does not want to undertake video interview with Police

Referral to SARC

CW complete initial risk and needs Assessment

Child agrees to undertake a video interview

ABE Interview at SARC

ISVA- Recovery Support Plan

Forensic/ wellbeing Examination

Early verbal report & short written Forensic & Health advice to Police & Social Services

Sexual Health follow up
Paediatrician follow up - SARC
Letting the Future in (NCPCC)

Child leaves SARC after Risk and Needs Assessment by Crisis Worker
