





## Jersey Safeguarding Adults Review - Keeping People Safe

### Accessible Information leaflet

 	<p><b>Jersey Safeguarding Adults Partnership Board</b> is a partnership of all the agencies who work together to support vulnerable adults to stay safe.</p> <p>Adult Safeguarding is about stopping people from being abused or neglected.</p> <p>The Jersey Safeguarding Adults Partnership Board have asked for a safeguarding adults review and as part of this to carry out a review of safeguarding for adults with a learning disability.</p>
	<p><b>Why Are Jersey Safeguarding Adults Partnership Board Carrying Out a Safeguarding Adult Review?</b></p> <p>The Safeguarding Adults Partnership Board wants to look at what is working well and what doesn't work well for keeping people safe.</p> <p>The board wants to learn how to make things better for people who live in Jersey.</p>
	<p><b>What is a Safeguarding Adult Review?</b></p> <p>A Safeguarding Adult Review is when people look at how well local organisations have worked together to keep people safe.</p> <p>The people doing the review will look at</p>



what was done over the last 12 months.

They will look at records about how people have been kept safe.

They might also want to look at care and support plans and what is written about a person. They will look at how people tried to help and if there was a good plan to keep a person safe?



The people doing the review will talk to people, their families and friends to find out what people think about their experiences about being helped to stay safe.

The safeguarding review will look at things like;

How well people are supported to know more about keeping safe and about their rights?



How people are helped to speak up for themselves.



If people listen when a person tells someone they are being abused?



If people are helped to make choices about how to stay safe? And do people feel safe?



And if people were happy with the way people tried to help them?



The people doing the review will visit providers of health and social care and talk to staff in different agencies to find out how they keep people safe.

They will ask staff their experiences of keeping people safe and if they worked together to stop people being abused?

The safeguarding adult review is not a Criminal Investigation or a Public Enquiry



### **Who Will Carry Out the Review?**

The people who will do the review are independent; this means they are not part of the Safeguarding Adults Partnership Board or any other organisation in Jersey.

They are people who have worked in health and social care organisations. They have experience in supporting people with a learning disability and in keeping people safe.



The names of the people who will be doing the safeguarding adults review are Sylvia Manson and Pete Morgan.

The names of the people doing the safeguarding review for people with a learning disability are Judi Thorley and Jackie Lawley.



### **How might I be asked to help?**

During July, August and September 2018 Sylvia, Pete, Judi and Jackie want to hear from people about what they think is working and what could be better about being helped to stay safe.



They will also want to talk to family carers and advocates.

They will want to meet with providers and talk to staff.

You do not have to do anything.

But if you would like to tell us what you think, there will a workshop and focus groups.

Information will be sent out to tell people about the dates and times to meet.

We will also meet people after the workshop to make sure we have spoken to more people, their families, advocates and staff.

When we look at records we will ask for consent to access these records and a separate consent form will be given to those people

#### **A Report will be written**


The report will be for the Jersey Safeguarding Adults Partnership Board at the end of September 2018.

This report will say what everyone has learnt from this review and what is agreed that needs to stay the same or be changed to make things better.

The final report will not show any details or information about the person or the families involved in the review.

Jersey Safeguarding Adults Partnership Board will then write an action plan to



	make sure changes are made to make things better.
