


## Jersey Safeguarding Adults Review - Keeping People Safe

















what was done over the last 12 months.

They will look at records about how people have been kept safe.

They might also want to look at care and support plans and what is written about a person. They will look at how people tried to help and if there was a good plan to keep a person safe?

The people doing the review will talk to people, their families and friends to find out what people think about their experiences about being helped to stay safe.

The safeguarding review will look at things like;

How well people are supported to know more about keeping safe and about their rights?

How people are helped to speak up for themselves.

If people listen when a person tells someone they are being abused?

If people are helped to make choices about how to stay safe? And do people feel safe?

And if people were happy with the way people tried to help them?



The people doing the review will visit providers of health and social care and talk to staff in different agencies to find out how they keep people safe.

They will ask staff their experiences of keeping people safe and if they worked together to stop people being abused?

The safeguarding adult review is not a Criminal Investigation or a Public Enquiry

## Who Will Carry Out the Review?

The people who will do the review are independent; this means they are not part of the Safeguarding Adults Partnership Board or any other organisation in Jersey.

They are people who have worked in health and social care organisations. They have experience in supporting people with a learning disability and in keeping people safe.

The names of the people who will be doing the safeguarding adults review are Sylvia Manson and Pete Morgan.

The names of the people doing the safeguarding review for people with a learning disability are Judi Thorley and Jackie Lawley.


## How might I be asked to help?
